For after-hours appointments, there will be a minimum two-hour fee of \$550 per inspector in addition to the standard user fee shown above. Two hours after the aircraft's scheduled arrival time, each additional 30 minutes required of the U.S. Customs Inspector will incur a \$80 fee above the \$550 minimum each.

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
Service & Daily Ramp Fee
