Re: Proposed FAA Flight Procedure Changes at Mesa Gateway Airport

Dear Mesa HOA Property Manager or Resident Representative,

As part of its Phoenix Area Modernization Project, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) recently released a **Draft Environmental Assessment (EA)** proposing new satellite-based departure flight procedures at Mesa Gateway Airport. Some of the proposed procedures could change where aircraft currently fly after takeoff, potentially routing flights over neighborhoods that have not historically been under departure flight paths. Mesa Gateway Airport Authority (MGAA) has reviewed the EA and has shared comments and concerns with the FAA.

MGAA believes it's very important that residents and community leaders have the opportunity to review the EA, and have their voices heard before the FAA makes a final decision on the project. There are two ways to participate:
